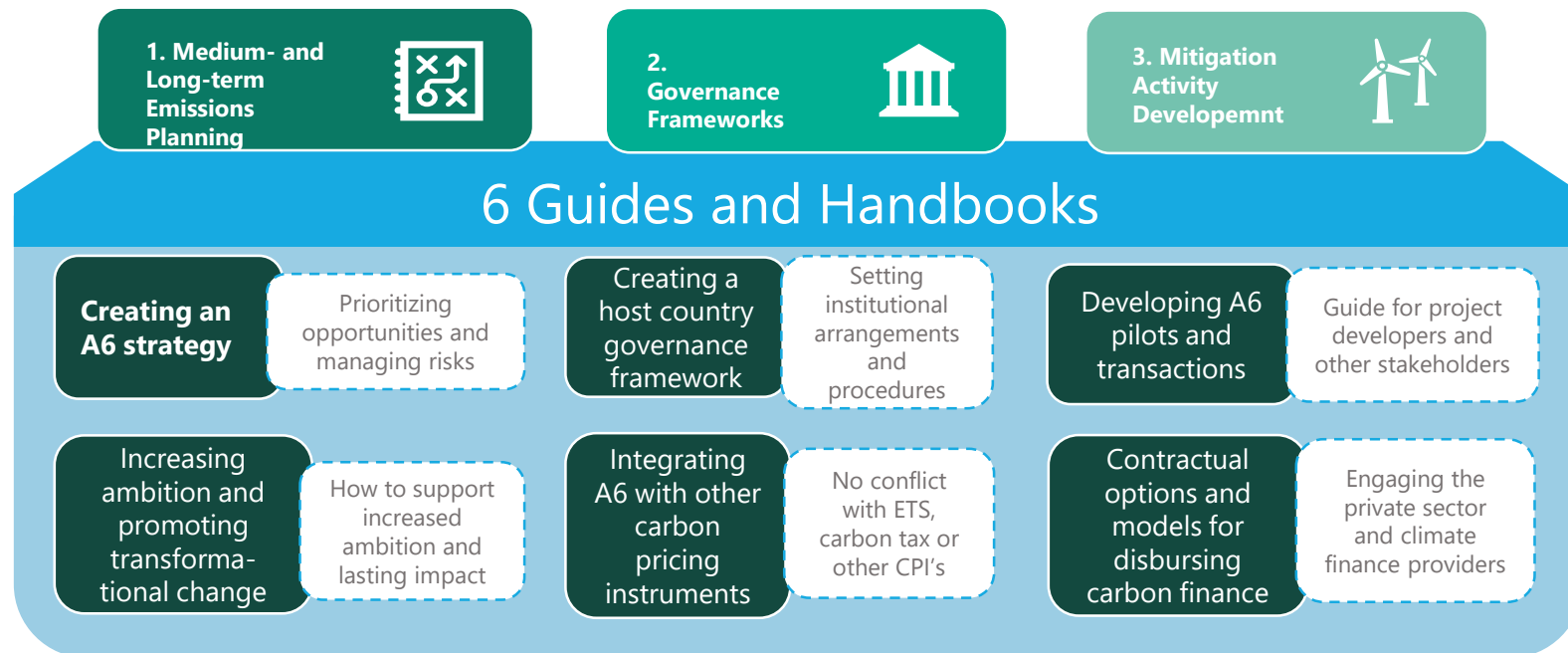
National and global support activities provided by SPAR6C

First versions under development, with iterative development throughout the project to reflect lessons learned

Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency – Global Support Programme (CBIT-GSP)

- Global transparency support project, funded by GEF, implemented by UNEP and executed UNEP-CCC, from 2022 to 2026 (~ 9 mio USD)
- Merging and continuation of CBIT Global Coordination Platform and the UNDP/UNEP Global Support Programme

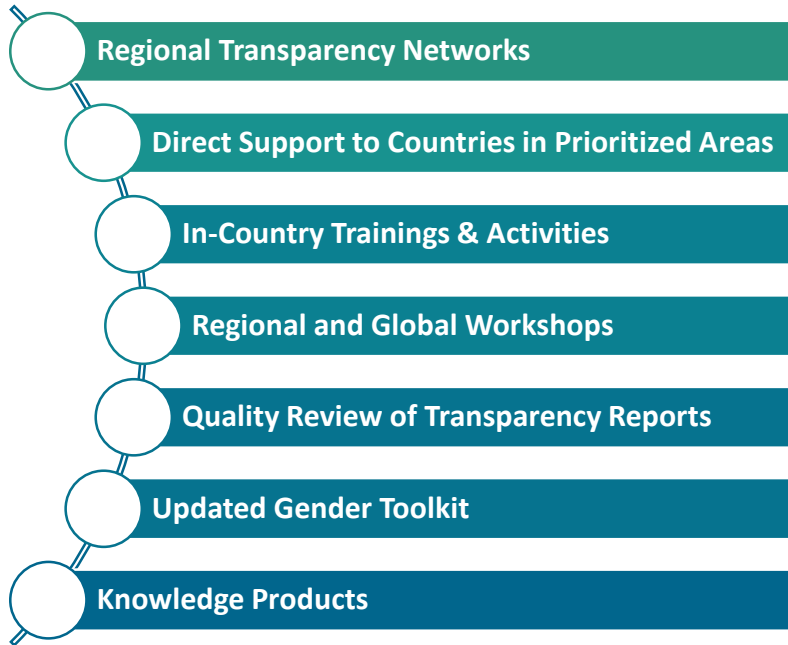

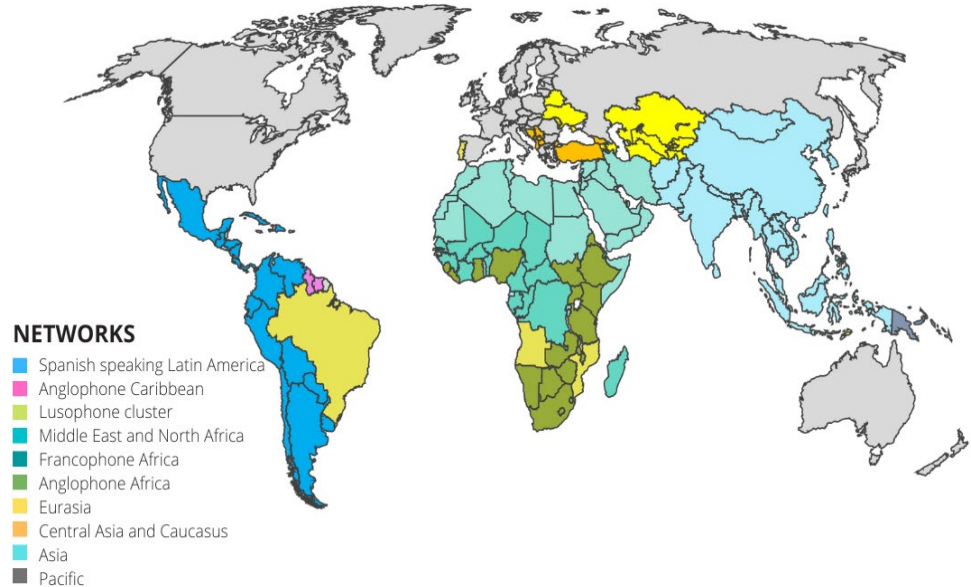

CBIT-GSP Integrated Platform: One-stop shop for transparency

Objective

Up-to-date information about all transparency projects, countries' transparency reports, transparency knowledge resources

One-stop-shop for transparency, owned by all transparency stakeholders

Up-to-date information on events, webinars, and calls for consultants on climate transparency

Place for peer-to-peer exchange on climate transparency issues, driven by the transparency networks

Platform currently under development
→ Launch during the SBs in Bonn

Main Features

- Country profiles and pages for all agencies and transparency support providers
- Dedicated space for Regional Transparency Networks, incl. a Forum
- Global Forum, Country Support Page etc.

CBIT-GSP Status

- Launch of six Regional Transparency Networks (two networks already in place with UNDP, two more to launch)
- Nomination of thematic focal points in countries
- Capacity needs assessment conducted in countries of the six networks to identify priorities and needs → [Several countries showed interest in support for reporting on Article 6 \(e.g., Lao PDR and Malaysia\)](#)
- Work plans for 2023 developed in each of the networks
- Article 6 support activities to be covered the future

Countries can ask for specific transparency support through a support request template at any time

Other Article 6 Projects at UNEP-CCC

Development of Carbon Market Transformational Change Tool, under the Initiative for Climate Action Transparency (ICAT)

- Develop self-assessment transformative impact templates for carbon market project/programme developers
- Develop the reporting format and guide for Article 6 purposes to safeguard environmental integrity and allow for NDC ambition raising. This will be integrated with NDC tracking as per Enhanced Transparency Framework requirements.

Integrated Assessment for Article 6 (upcoming)

- Develop a toolbox with technical modules developed for integrated assessment for Article 6 readiness building on existing international methodologies, tools, and datasets for analysis of mitigation costs and potential, policies and project development, dynamic baselines, iterative stakeholder engagement and impact assessment aligned with MRV/transparency and transformational change approaches to a just, sustainability transition.
- The toolbox will build on Costa Rica's open-source Climate Change Metric System (SINAMECC) and its Climate-Land-Energy-Water (CLEW) modelling platform, among other publicly available resources and draw on standardised data structures such as GHG inventories and REDD reference levels.
