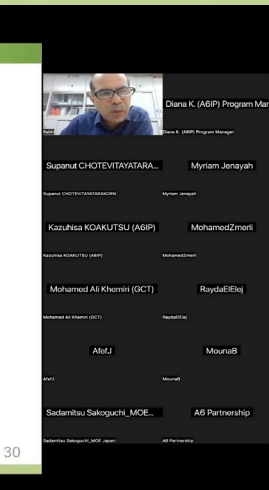
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## 3.5 How to report on Authorization?

Authorization triggers a reporting requirement.
